Northern access - petition

vehicles except buses and emergency services. However, a number of Loves Farm residents have expressed an interest in opening up the Northern access to cars.

You can help take action by signing a petition online through our website. You have until 15th September to sign the petition, after which it will be submitted to Cambridgeshire County Council for their consideration.

Opening the access to all traffic will provide benefits to all residents - wherever you live on the development:

- Reduced traffic flows
- Reduced congestion on Cambridge Road/Cambridge Street by providing good alternative routes to St Neots town car parks, etc.
- Reduced travelling by up to 3.5 miles on return journeys to Huntingdon and other destinations north with little or no increase in traffic on Priory Hill.
