LFCA grants are only available to <u>non-profit</u> making groups that are based on Love's Farm and/or directly benefit Love's Farm residents. Any such group must be consistent with the broad aims and objectives of LFCA and reflect those aims and objectives in their membership and organisation. In order to maximise the number of local groups which can benefit from a LFCA grant, only one grant per group will normally be considered. Any approval of a grant does not imply any further funding for this or related projects in the future.

- Once a grant is approved, payment will not be made until a receipt has been submitted.
- The approved grant must only be used for the purposes outlined in the application.
- The grant cannot be used for payment of goods or services bought or ordered before the grant was approved.
- Any equipment or assets purchased with the grant may not be sold or disposed of without prior approval from LFCA.
- The delivery of the project for which a grant has been awarded must comply with all relevant legislation and insurance requirements
