Countdown To Love's Farm House Launch Festival

Saturday 24 October, 4pm

Love's Farm House will open its doors in October with a week of celebrations. We start on Saturday 24 October 2015 at 4pm with the **Love's Farm Expo**. It's your chance to see the building, meet the people who will be hosting activities and find out about all the projects Love's

Farm Community Association is running across Love's Farm. There will be craft activities, a barbecue, face painting and we'll be burying a time capsule in the garden. From 6:30pm there'll be live music, the LFCA **Community Champion Awards**, a **barn dance** and **disco**, so wear your dancing shoes!

Launch Festival Week

The rest of launch week is jam packed with special events and free taster classes to showcase activities that will be available at Love's Farm House. See the back page of this newsletter for full listings.

Sunday 25 October

At 10am we have **Breakfast Church**. It's run by Helene the Love's Farm Community Chaplain (with lots of help), and welcomes all ages to eat, read the papers, find space to explore questions about faith and doubt, and consider how an ancient story relates to life today.

At 2pm we will be screening **Big Hero 6 (PG)**, an action-packed comedy-adventure from the team behind Frozen and Wreck-It Ralph.

Monday 26 October

In the morning there are three free taster classes for **Hartbeeps**, multisensory, developmentally directed, musical storytelling sessions for babies, toddlers and their grown ups.

At 3pm there's an **NCT Mother & Baby Yoga** taster class, gentle yoga-based exercises for both mums and babies to do together from six weeks after birth.

At 4:45pm we have **Pop Movers**, where boys and girls aged 5-9 will learn dance routines to their favourite pop songs.

At 7pm there's **Yoga** for adults. Suitable for beginners and the more experienced, it will incorporate breathing exercises, movement.

meditation and relaxation.



Tuesday 27 October

At 10am and 11:15am **Baby Sensory** introduces you and your baby to a world of rich and varied sensory experiences to encourage learning and development.

At 5pm, the **Love's Farm Youth Club** for 8-to-14 year olds moves to its new home.

Annie Morton's **Pilates Professional** classes come to Love's Farm House at 7 and 8pm, with free entry to newcomers.

Wednesday 28 October

The first of our **Coffee Mornings** in the foyer, plus **Yoga** at 10:30am and **Little Starlings** under-5s drop in at 1:30pm.

Music for Little People at 9:30am for 3-5s and 10:30am for 0-2s, where they discover music with colourful props and puppets.

At 7:30pm we will be screening **Mad Max:** Fury Road (15), the 2015 reboot of George Miller's deranged post-apocolyptic saga.

Thursday 29 October

We bring you **My Pet Monster and Me!** by the acclaimed Blunderbus Theatre. It's a farmyard adventure especially for little monsters aged 3-7

and their grown-ups. Tickets are just £2 in advance (see the back page for details).

Friday 30 October

At 10:30am St Neots Library brings **Baby** and **Toddler Rhymetime** to Love's Farm.

At 6:15pm we have **Burlesque Fitness**, a mischievous exercise class combining a cardio workout and burlesque tease.

At 7:30pm the **LFCA Quiz** takes up its new residency at the **Farm House Bar**, which will be open every Friday evening.

Saturday 31 October

From 9:30am there are taster **Street Dance** classes for 4-6 and 7-10 year olds.

At 6pm we round up our launch week with a **Family Halloween Disco**. Tickets cost £1 and will be available throughout launch week. Start planning your costumes now!

Having opened in December 2014, Loves Farm Pharmacy has quickly flourished into an innovative and respected local name, with caring for the residents of St Neots at its heart. who are unable or too busy to collect their prescriptions themselves.

The pharmacy is located next to the train station and is open 6 days a week (Monday to Friday 9am-1pm and 2pm-6pm, and Saturday 9am-1pm).

Other services include flu vaccinations, which will be offered from 1st October with no appointment necessary, and which will be available free to those who are eligible (i.e. patients over 65 years old). A Travel Clinic, where a full range of vaccinations such as yellow fever, meningitis B, chickenpox and malaria medication are available, is run on an appointment basis.

Loves Farm Pharmacy also provides a mole screening service and a free minor ailments service. The pharmacy staff are able to dispense medicines such as paracetamol, ibuprofen liquids and other medications for minor ailments such as head lice, hay fever and indigestion. These are available free to those who are eligible for free medication under the NHS.

It's great to have such a useful range of services on our doorstep, so let's give them our support and keep them busy.

Love's Farm Running Club


Tuesdays, 8-9pm
