## Restricting Parking on Love's Farm – Your Comments Needed!

In our previous update (Love's Farm News, April 2017) we reported that Cambs County Council (CCC) had agreed funding for parking restrictions on Love's Farm.

Following discussions with LFCA, CCC has developed some outline proposals, for which they have asked us to hold an initial informal consultation. After years of lobbying this feels like real progress and it is important that as many residents as possible use this opportunity to get the scheme you want.

Based on the results of the initial consultation CCC will do further work on the detail of the scheme, and a second, formal consultation will then be run, probably in early 2018.

Timescales are dictated by the need to get the scheme implemented within the current financial year. From the residents' viewpoint, it's worth noting that the parking restrictions in Longsands (other side of the railway) are now being enforced by the Police and so it's likely that commuter parking will move to Love's Farm in the absence of restrictions here.

## What is Proposed?

### **Spine Roads (Stone Hill, Great High Ground, Dramsell Rise, Station Square, Kester Way, Hogsden Leys)**

No parking (double yellow lines) on all of these except for specific parking areas on each of the roads – a draft map of these is available at [www.ourlovesfarm.co.uk/parking](http://www.ourlovesfarm.co.uk/parking). The specific parking areas on Station Square and Kester Way would be time limited (probably two hours maximum) to assist with station dropping off and visiting shops, Leonardo's and Love's Farm House. Other designated parking on spine roads will not be time restricted.

### **Side roads (all other roads that will be adopted by CCC)**

Three options are proposed for the initial consultation:

- (a) no restrictions on side roads (as per the current situation)
- (b) restricted parking e.g. single yellow line with one hour of no parking (probably 11am to midday, or midday to 1pm)
- (c) full restrictions – double yellows on side roads.

Within these options (b) and (c) it is envisaged that a small number of parking bays would be identified that don't block the flow of traffic, and would remain with no restrictions.

If (b) or (c) was implemented, there may be an option for specific side roads to be excluded based on residents' feedback (except near the junction to spine roads). However, implementing a mix of (a), (b) and (c)

within one road is likely to be too costly in terms of consultation and design.

On-street parking may not currently be a significant problem on your street, but bear in mind that it may increase if and when other streets adopt restrictions, and if commuters learn where the pockets of unrestricted parking are located.

## A New School for Love's Farm Residents



A group of Love's Farm residents have spent the past year campaigning to increase primary

school provision for Love's Farm. As the population on Love's Farm has grown – and with an unusually high proportion of young families – the effective catchment area for the Round

House school has shrunk significantly, leaving families on many streets to the north and south of Love's Farm missing out on a place and having to travel to other schools in St Neots.

Cambridgeshire County Council was unable to find a solution for September 2017 but it has assured the campaign team that there will be additional places created for Love's Farm children in reception and year one for September 2018. The most likely scenario appears to be a new school on the Wintringham Park development, on the other side of Cambridge Road to the south of Love's Farm. Wintringham Park is currently in pre-planning stage, with negotiations between developers Urban and Civic and Hunts District Council. If it all goes smoothly, planning permission will be granted within the next few months and Urban and Civic hopes to start building in late 2018. The development previously included two two-form-entry primary schools, one of which will be increased to three-form entry to accommodate the overflow from Love's Farm.

That won't be quick enough to deliver a new school for September 2018, so the proposal is that the school will initially open in temporary buildings – and at a temporary location. Despite many uncertainties, the County Council are ploughing ahead with the commissioning of the new school, and two sponsors are bidding to run it. One is the Diamond Learning Partnership Trust, which runs The Round House (as well as Winhills and Middlefield). The other is The St Neots Learning Partnership, which runs



Longsands and Ernulf secondary schools. The Diamond Learning Partnership Trust have proposed that the new school would be a sister school to the Round House, with (Round House headteacher) Mrs Bryden as its executive head and with temporary buildings on the Round House site. The St Neots Learning Partnership has suggested it would house temporary buildings on its Longsands site.

Both trusts made presentations at a public meeting on 27 September, and were interviewed by a panel at the County Council on 29 September. The council will make a recommendation to the Department for Education for its preferred sponsor. The successful sponsor should be announced soon.

The campaign group is particularly interested in how each trust proposes to manage the school so that pupils still feel part of the Love's Farm community. They are very keen that the new school feels part of Love's Farm, and children attending both the new school and The Round House feel part of the same community. The council has assured them that they share this priority, and that this will be considered as part of the selection process.

There is still much uncertainty, making it difficult for parents of children who are due to start school in September 2018 to select their preferred schools by January 2018. The council assured those attending the meeting on 27

## Northern Access Closed to Emergency Vehicles

In early August the northern access to Love's Farm was closed to all vehicles including emergency services. Concerned residents raised the issue of lack of emergency access to the north of the estate at a recent meeting with Cambs County Council Highways, who are currently consulting on permanently closing the northern access to all vehicles. Highlighting the concern that a third of the estate would be stranded should there be an accident on Stone Hill coupled with increased response times by emergency services, Highways have agreed to remove the concrete block and look to install manual bollards for emergency vehicles which would replace the costly mechanised ones.
